A show and tell activity was organized for the Independence day celebration on August 13, 2018 where children came dressed in tricolour clothes and spoke a few lines on different National symbols.






YOUNG ACHIEVERS COMPETITION






Grade I


Grade I

THE CLUB ACTIVITY

'Creative Club' engrossed the children in making keychain using tricolor beads, ribbons and thread. The 'Life skill Club' involved the children to understand the meaning of "Unity is strength" they watched videos based on the same and was followed by a worksheet. In 'Speech and Debate Club' the children prepared on the topic : Unity in diversity in, Cultures & Traditions of India, States of India, Flora and Fauna of India and Festivals of India. The children were also shown the PPT on the symbols of India and were asked to draw and colour symbols in their scrapbook. The 'Cookery Club' was a fun filled for the children as they learnt how to make 'Russian salad' and 'Tiranga barfi'. DODGE BALL MATCHES








Grade III






Grade XI-XII
