## Vision

Founded in April 2001, NMS has a strength of 3850 students and 400 faculty members. Located in the cosmopolitan metropolis of Jaipur, we have developed a student body that hails from all parts of India and the world. Our staff and faculty are highly qualified, progressive, and resonate with the same diversity as our children. We are dedicated to academic excellence and to the development of self confident individuals of good character who will be able to bring out the best in themselves through their academic and personal growth. In our pursuit of excellence, well known personalities from diverse fields like Theatre, Music, Dance, Academics and Sports are invited on campus to conduct workshops for students and interact with faculty.

## Mission

Our unique approach to preparing a child begins with the fundamentals of learning. NMS recognises some students learn best by reading; some through actual experience; some by pursuing deep interest. At NMS many path exists in partnership, and students are guided and encouraged to find paths that are most effective for them.

## Academic Calendar

NMS operates on a semester calendar, with Semester 1 from April to September & Semester 2 from October to March.



## Grading System

In Grades IX and X, the grading is A\* to U for those doing the IGCSE (with A\* the highest) & in CBSE students are awarded a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) ranging from 10 pt. to 1 pt. with 10 being the highest. In XI & XII, students doing the CBSE curriculum are awarded percentage marks in their 5 main subjects & the IBDP students receive the IB grades of 7 to 1 (with 7 as the highest) per subject for six subjects & 3 additional points for TOK, EE and CAS.

## Objectives

In all its programs, NMS seeks to discover and nurture the special gifts each student possesses; to deepen each student's understanding of the complexities of the world and to inspire each to his or her full potential.

- By stressing high academic standards through a strong commitment to the process of learning.
- By stressing the fundamental values of integrity trust and discipline.
- By having students participate in various athletic and extracurricular activities combined with academic life to provide opportunities for personal growth, and to prepare students to take their place as global citizens.
- By fostering traditional values of empathy, compassion and respect towards others and the environment.
- By encouraging global mindedness through interactions and exchange programs with organisations, institutions and universities around the world.
- By providing state-of-the-art facilities, technologies and infrastructure to optimize teaching and learning outcomes.
- By building a community of outstanding and caring educators, with rich experience and multi-cultural perspectives and providing them with ongoing professional development.

## Academic Curriculum

The School prepares students for the Indian National curriculum-CBSE Board as well as the International curriculum-comprising of IGCSE and the IBDP. In Grades 1 to 10, students choose either the Central Board of Secondary Education programme (CBSE) or the University of Cambridge's International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) programme. Students in Grades XI & XII pursue the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBD) Programme or the CBSE programme. In CBSE the school offers all three streams-Science, Commerce & Humanities -totaling to about 20+ subjects. Sports, Visual and Performing Arts as well as Yoga are an integral part of every student's life in School.



## Subject Matrix

**CBSE curriculum:** In Grades IX and X, students enroll in 5 subjects which include two languages: (English compulsory) and a choice of second language from Hindi, Sanskrit or French; Mathematics; Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) and Social Science (History, Geography, Political Science & Economics). In Grades XI and XII a student may choose any 5 subjects to study for two continuous years. They are also graded for Work Education, Physical & Health Education and General Studies.

**International Curriculum:** In IGCSE Grades IX & X students enroll for a minimum of 6 & maximum of 9 courses. In IB Grades XI & XII students take 6, two year course (3 at higher level & 3 at standard level), a Theory of Knowledge course, 4000 word Extended Essay & a minimum of 150 hours of Creativity, Action & Service project. Students in Grade IX & X take the **PSAT** Exam conducted by College Board for which the school is a centre. Students in Grade X, XI and XII are also offered tutorials for **AP (Advance Placement)** Courses and the school is an AP test centre. All students interested in studying overseas take the ACT/SAT tests. School is also a ACT test centre.

## National and International Achievements

- 6 students of grade XI and XII qualified for The **Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana (KVPPY)**, an on-going National Program of Fellowship in Basic Sciences, initiated and funded by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, to attract exceptionally highly motivated students for pursuing basic science courses and research career in science. - 5 students of grade X qualified the **National Talent Search Examination (NTSE)** through a selection procedure comprising of a written examination. In all 4000 students get selected from the country.
- 1 of our gr. XI student secured **World Rank-2** in the International Spell Bee Contest-2015 held at Abu Dhabi.
- 2 students achieved **All India Rank-1** in International Olympiad of English Language and Unified International English Olympiad respectively.
- 24 out of 38 students who appeared of XII qualified the **Joint Entrance Examination- Mains** (2014-15) for Engineering.
- 8 students fall in the **top 100 International Rank** in the Olympiads Foundation (SOF) with 3 in National Science Olympiad (NSO), 2 in



International English Olympiad (IEO), 2 in National Cyber Olympiad (NCO) and 1 in International Mathematics Olympiad.

•One of our girl student is the only girl in Rajasthan to have ever got selected at **Caltech**, also one student received a full **TATA scholarship at Cornell University**.

### Student Opportunities

•Students actively participate in sporting and co-curricular activities at the State, National as well as International Level and are also supported by trained faculty to deliver their best at all platforms.

•The school has a very active student led **MUN** program for the last 7 years. The annual Neerja Modi Model United nations (**NMMUN**) conference provides great opportunities for students to deliberate on contemporary, social & critical issues faced by the world and helps them develop leadership qualities.

•With the growing appreciation of TED Talks as a teaching & learning tool and a catalyst for innovation & change, our school has formally launched **TEDx Youth** recently and had organised the first show on Oct 12, 2015 with the speakers from different sectors.

•NMS has a strong **STEM** program which helps children understand and apply concepts in subjects like Math, Science and English. As part of this program, children build practical solutions using Audio & Video, Tablets, Robotics, Math & Science projects along with design thinking. With projects that also include English Language Arts, Social Sciences and Digital Media, it engages the 'whole mind' catering to the development of both - left-brain (analytical) and right brain (artistic) capabilities of children.

•NMS is also a member of International Award for Young People (IAYP) which encourages over all development of young adults by challenging them in four areas- physical recreation, skills, service and expeditions.

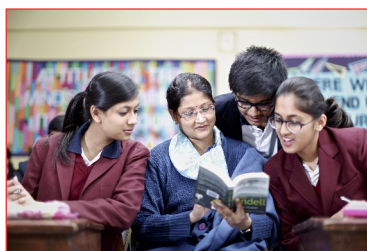

A highly valued & integral part of our community outreach is the Neerja Modi Arts Centre, better known as a comprehensive arts resource in our region, where the artist in all of us, from the newly-awakened to the long-established connect with reputed local & foreign artists to make aesthetics an innate part of life.

### Community Services

Education is empowerment and at Nischay, we envision a fully literate society which can only be accomplished if the 'Women' of tomorrow are literate and self reliant. In Rajasthan, education of under privileged women is a rarity and there is high rate of female infanticide. As a part of our school's vision to empower these girls which will help them achieve their goals and be able to change their future. This dream would not be possible if they were uneducated. Nischay is a unique initiative promoted under the aegis of Shri Modi Shikshan Sansthan. It is a comprehensive school till grade X which strives to educate under privileged girls totally free of cost-which includes uniform, school bags, books, mid-day meals and conveyance facilities. At present apart from the basic infrastructure, there is a fully equipped computer lab and a vast play ground with slides and swings. Vocational expertise is imparted to the girls in our sewing and crafts room, baking & confectionary. On the academic front, the quality of education is ascertained by well qualified teachers. The school also encourages international volunteers to work with our Nischay. Students from Grade IV to XII of Neerja Modi School are involved with these girls through teaching various subjects/ mentoring/ becoming role models/ Dance/ Art/ Sports/ Photography/ Digital learning. 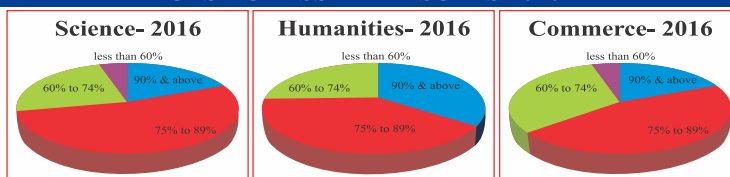

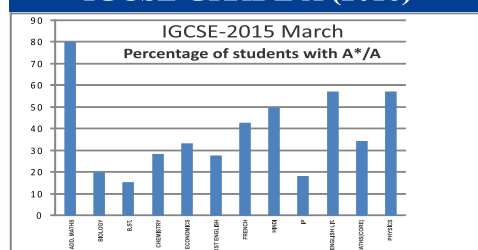

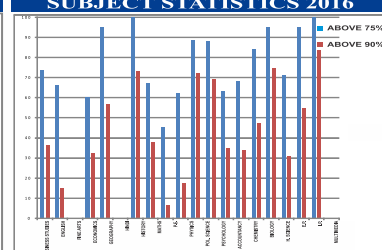
### CBSE CLASS XII RESULTS 2016
