#### STUDENT OPPORTUNITIES

The school has run an active student-led MUN (Model United Nations) program for the last 10 years. As TED Talks have increasingly become a teaching and learning tool, as well as a catalyst for innovation & change, our students have taken the lead to organise TEDx Youth and Tedx Kids events. NMS student speakers who have made remarkable differences in the community are chosen to become speakers. NMS has a dynamic STEM club, which convenes weekly to contribute to the technological advancement of the school. They have introduced Robotics in the 2016-17 academic year and have now set up a Robotics Lab and Innovation Centre.

The most popular event is the start-up competition: a competition where students get the opportunity to present and pitch their start-up ideas. 


#### CBSE GRADE X (2019)




### CBSE CLASS XII RESULTS 2019









#### IGCSE SUBJECT STATISTICS 10th 2018-19
