The most popular event is the start-up competition: a competition where students get the opportunity to present and pitch their start-up ideas.
- NMS is also a member of International Award for Young People (IAYP) which encourages overall development of young adults by challenging them in four areas: physical recreation, skills, service and expeditions.
- The Jaipur Debate organised by the debate society of NMS has also become a popular national competition, involving the participation of schools nationwide.

Community Service: Nischay is a community outreach programme which strives to educate underprivileged girls free of cost: uniforms, school bags, books, mid-day meals and conveyance facilities are all covered. Vocational expertise is imparted in our sewing and crafts room, as well as our baking & confectionery classes.

Students from Grade 4 to 12 engage with Nischay by teaching various subjects, mentoring the girls and sharing subjects like dance, art, sports, photography, and digital learning. These community activities bring the students together and help foster values of empathy, compassion and respect towards others.

Sports Facilities: NMS has state of the art facilities including a football field, a cricket ground (International Standard), a 400 m athletic track, courts for tennis, basketball, badminton & volleyball, horse riding, cricket nets, table tennis, squash & swimming. The school hosts inter-school tournaments & our teams participate at the district, state and national levels in the following: chess, squash, tennis, badminton, athletics, basketball, football, archery, cricket, swimming and table tennis.

Student Leadership: Nominations for the members of student council are made by the teachers and student community, followed by rigorous interviews and individual presentations. The members selected display extraordinary leadership towards responsibilities taken. They imbibe and implement ethos of the school, have a strong commitment to give back to the school community, and inspire their peers and juniors through exemplary actions.

Career and Counselling Services: NMS helps students build upon their positive experiences at NMS to gain admission into colleges and universities in India and all over the world.

Our comprehensive counseling program guides and supports students throughout the university application process, beginning in Grade 9 and continuing up to Grade 12.

Boarding Facilities:

ACADEMIC CURRICULUM

We operate on a semester calendar with Semester 1 from April to September and Semester 2 from October to March.

International IGCSE and IB Diploma Program:

- IGCSE 9-10: a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 10 subjects
- IBSDP 11-12: 3 subjects at Higher Level and 3 at Standard Level, TOK course, 4000 word Extended Essay and minimum of 150 hours of CAS

National CBSE:

- CBSE 9-10: 5 subjects - English, Hindi, Sanskrit or French; Math; Science and Social Science
- CBSE 11-12: Streams offered - Science, Commerce and Humanities
 - 5 subjects to study for 2 continuous years
 - Graded for work education, physical health education and general studies

GRADING

- CBSE in grades 9 & 10: Grade points from 4-10, with 10 being the highest
- CBSE in grades 11 & 12: Marks from 1-100, with 100 being the highest
- IGCSE in grades 9 & 10: Percentage grades corresponding with letters A to G, A being the highest (90%-100%)
- IBDP: Grades 1-7, with 7 being the highest
