Collage Making



The day unfolded some interesting activities planned for the children, such as movies, paper crafts, outdoor games, indoor games etc.



Grade 2 students visited the G.P.O , Jaipur on 10th November, 2017 as where they learnt 'Letter writing' as part of their English Curriculum. The children and teachers were welcomed warmly by the staff at the Post- office. The tour started with a visit to the 'Philatelic Bureau and Museum'. The little museum has historical stamps, telegrams and artefacts, including brass belt buckles and badges for mail runners and packers. The students listened excitedly about the early days when the postmen were armed with swords, spears and pistols to deal with wild animals and dacoits (bandits). Next, the students had a peek into the normal working day of a Post Office. They were explained the entire process of how letters are collected, segregated, stamped and then stored in pigeon holes for the postmen to collect. After that, the students also had a glance of the various counters catering to the public, namely those selling stamps, envelopes, postcards, courier services, saving account etc. It was also explained the way parcels are delivered to different places in the city and places in the country as well as to other countries too! The student got to see a mail van and were also told the way the letters go by van to the airport and railway station. Children posted the letters they had written to their parents. It was delightful to see the excitement on the children's faces as they posted their envelopes in the post box and they were too eager to find their parents surprised. Finally, the students were treated with sweets and were gifted a Limited edition envelopes (Ponna Horse) by the officials.

The students thoroughly enjoyed their visit and it was altogether a great learning experience for the students as they really valued the services rendered by the Indian Postal Services.


They also created beautiful collages by pasting pictures of the physical features on the map of Rajasthan in a group activity.


National Integration NCC Camp


